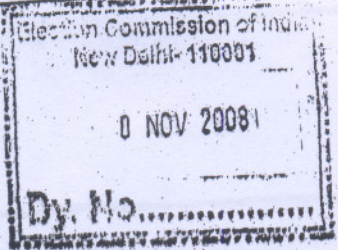


Sir,
